The trip details, chaperon's responsibilities and qualifications are detailed below:

Trip Details:

- 1) **Trip's Purpose-** To give members of our delegation (students and adults) the opportunity to foster positive relationships and appreciation of our respective cultures
- 2) **Travel Dates-** The group will fly out at night of Friday, April 8th, and return on Sunday, April 17th (the week of Spring Break).
- 3) **Cost to Teacher/Chaperone-** \$300 to help with the cost of the round-trip airfare, All other costs, including room/food/travel, will be cover by the Sister City Association.
- 4) **Food/Lodging-** All your meals will be taken care of (you'll have opportunities to taste a variety of the best Taiwanese/Chinese food), and you will stay in a 4 or 5 star hotel that provides a full American, European, or Asian buffet Breakfast- whichever you prefer.
- 5) **Primary Responsibilities** - assist in interviewing and selecting student delegation; accompany/chaperone the students on the plane; visit various schools the students visit during the days; attend official city/school meetings, luncheons and dinners arranged by the Program hosts in Hsinchu. Deal effectively with any problems our kids might have during their stay there which might require email or phone correspondence with their parents back home; and smile a lot and do your best to be a good diplomat and enjoy your experience there.
The selected chaperon teacher will be a member of the 2016 Student Exchange Program, and may be invited to attend/support other activities by the CHSCA.

Desirable Qualifications

- 1) Be a competent, enthusiastic teacher who likes traveling with kids for educational reasons.
- 2) Has some travel experience, preferably abroad.
- 3) Interest and openness for experiencing and learning more about foreign cultures particularly Asian culture(s).
